- MEMORIZE YOURSIDES




ASK YOURSELF:

• GET CAMERA READY

Fresh face Simple Wardrobe No Logos No Graphics or busy materials

• TAKE ONE - PRACTICE

- Use this to get the "nerves out"
 - Did you follow the submission instructions?
 - Do you believe in your character?
- Check your lighting & sound. Make adjustments as necessary
- Check your framing



• TAKE TWO

Use your notes

TAKE THREE

- Do you need more?
- Which is your favorite?
- Would you say you are 90% happy? Do you think you can improve?



Editing

- Trim the videos & take out extra time that is not part of the audition
- DO NOT clip together different parts of the scene to make one scene.
- Do the entire scene in a take.
 - Save file as instructed
 - Industry Standard mp4 file
 - Label the file:
