

MASTERS TEEN ACTING PROGRAM

Our Masters class is dedicated to advanced student actors who want to take their acting to the next level. The program will challenge their work, identify intention, specify objectives and always assist students' in rooting themselves and their work in truth. In addition to fine tuning our students' acting skills, we also identify the steps it takes to become a working actor, how to navigate the industry as a professional and hone work ethic. We'll focus on auditioning (in person and self tapes), resume writing & headshots, self promotion, how to submit/select representation, character development, scene study and so much more. Students are encouraged to meet outside of class time to rehearse with scene partners and to come to class prepared and memorized. Auditions are required. Accepted student actors must commit to the program for the school year (September - June).

Additional requirements include volunteering at studio events, shadowing beginner and intermediate classes, attendance to special events outside of class/studio time.

Masters Teen Actors and Families agree to the following:

- Attendance is mandatory on a weekly basis.
- Punctuality is essential; please arrive on time for all classes and activities.
- In the event of sickness or an acting booking, make-up classes will be required.
- Enrollment in the program extends from September to June. If you need to cancel before the end of the term, families will be responsible for the remaining tuition for the year.
- Participation in the Masters Short Film Fundraising and Production is expected.
- Dedicate a minimum of 2 hours per month to volunteering, assisting other classes, spending time in the Studio, and supporting coaches with classes.
- Students will be required to attend 4-6 additional activities throughout the year, which will be announced well in advance. If attendance is not possible, please communicate with your coach.
- Attend outings on non-class days, such as tours of casting studios, The Studio NW events, and Make-A-Movie screenings.
- Embrace marketing opportunities, such as helping at festivals and trade events, promoting the studio and each other.
- Masters will actively manage their presence on social media, ensuring that they represent themselves and the studio in a positive light.

These additional activities can also contribute to high school volunteer requirements and add value to your resume and college applications.

ADVANCED ACTING CLASS

This class is for the student actor ready to take on more challenging material and commitment to training for acting in TV & Film. The Advanced class is for student actors who are interested in joining our Masters Acting Program in the future. Actors have either been part of our program and invited by the instructors or have auditioned and accepted into the class. All are excited about acting for TV/Film!

The Advanced class will build a solid foundation in a variety of acting techniques (Meisner based training), learn and refine their auditioning skills (self-tape and live), deep dive into character development, work on scenes with fellow classmates, tap into original material and so much more. We provide opportunities for our students to share original material and receive feedback in a safe, creative environment with the trust of their fellow classmates. Our student actors have many opportunities to perform on-camera and review taped work to build confidence and refine technique.

The Advanced Acting class does not have the specific requirements as our Masters Teen Acting Program. Students are encouraged to meet outside of class time to rehearse with scene partners and to come to class prepared and memorized. This class does have additional opportunities to attend outings on non-class days. We will have one or two activities that will be required to attend. These are in addition to regular classes. Advanced notice will be provided. Students will need to connect with their coach if attendance is not possible. We will also have other events that students will be invited to but not required. For example tours of casting studios, The Studio NW events, Make-A-Movie screenings.
